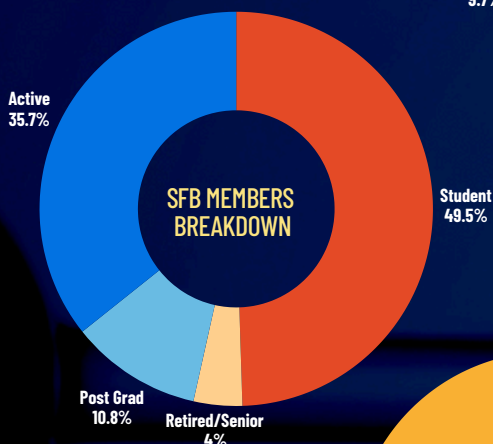
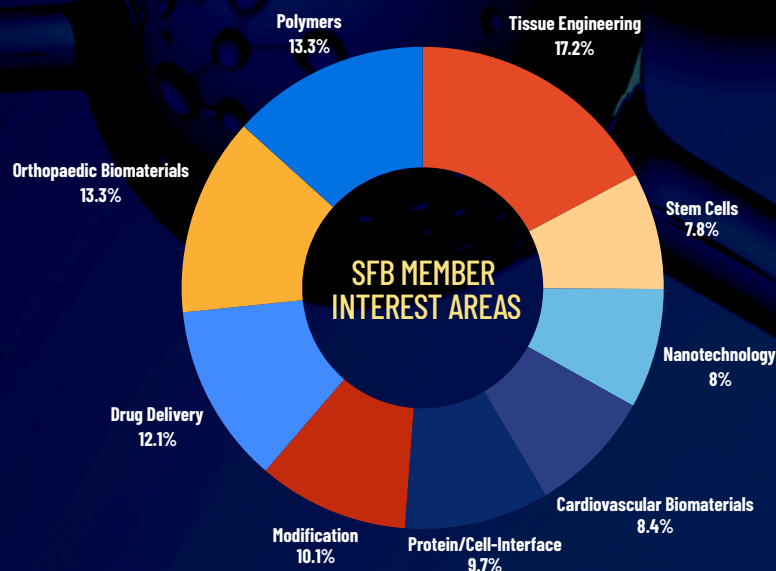
WHAT WE DO

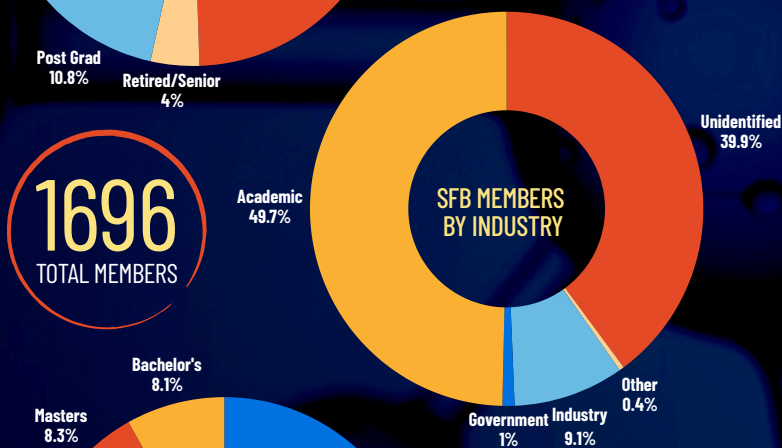
MISSION

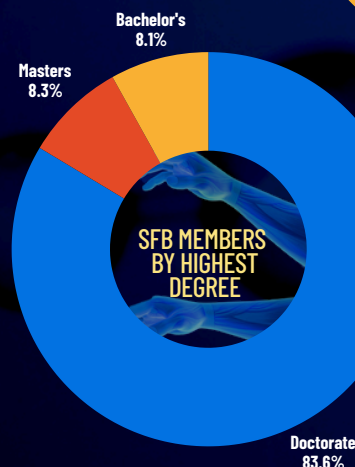

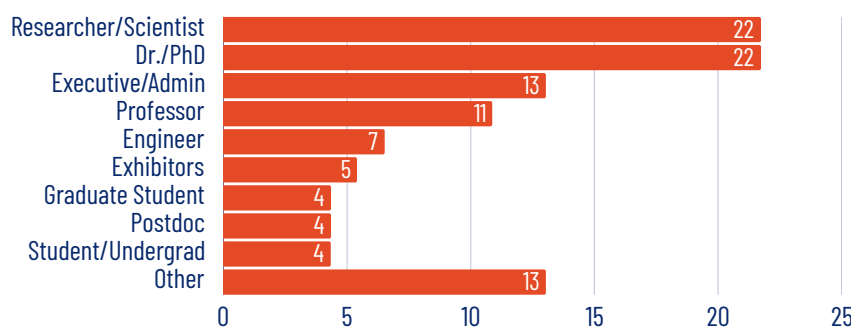


ABOUT THE ANNUAL MEETING
